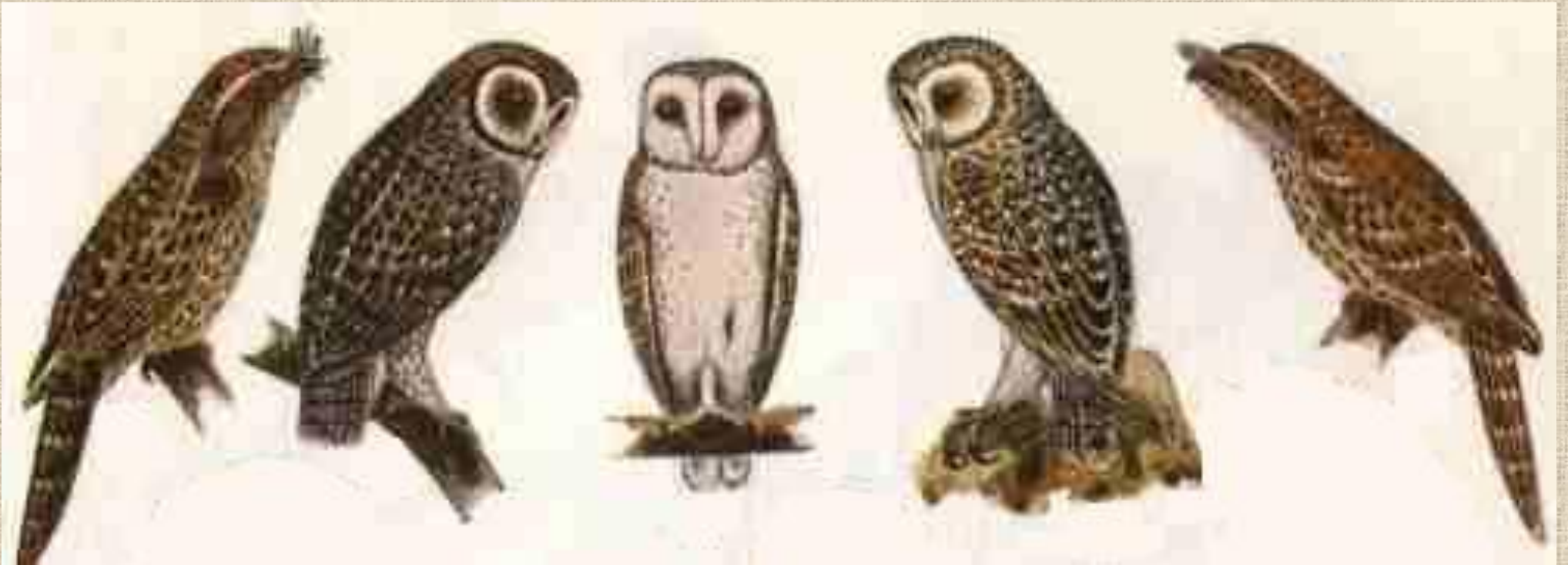


# What Bird Is That Quiz

These discovery pages were designed to introduce children to the birds of Australia through pictures. Each page identifies a group of birds linked using their habitat, size or family.

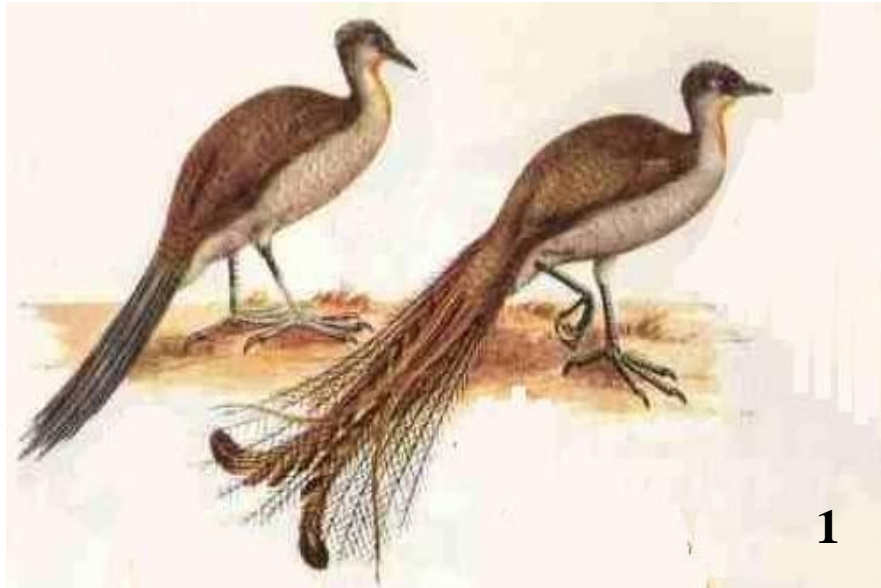
This resource is very flexible. Here are a few ideas.

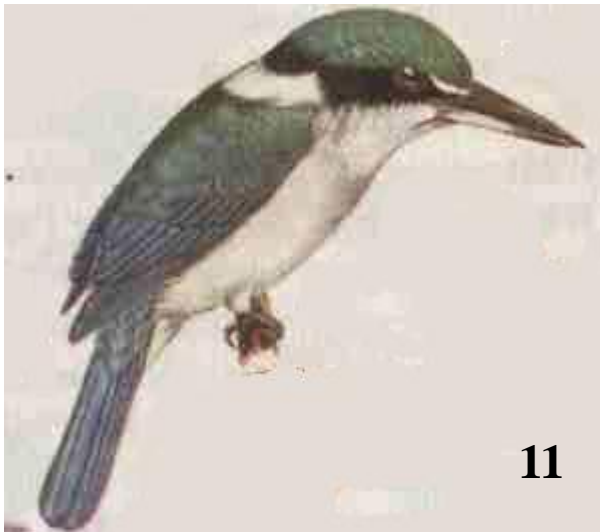
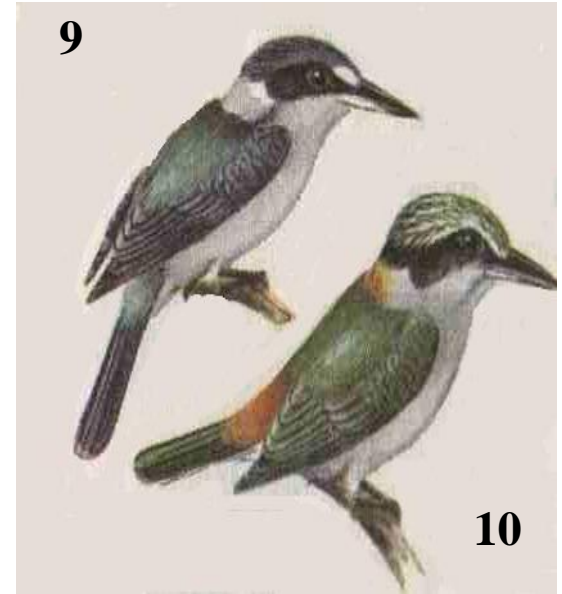
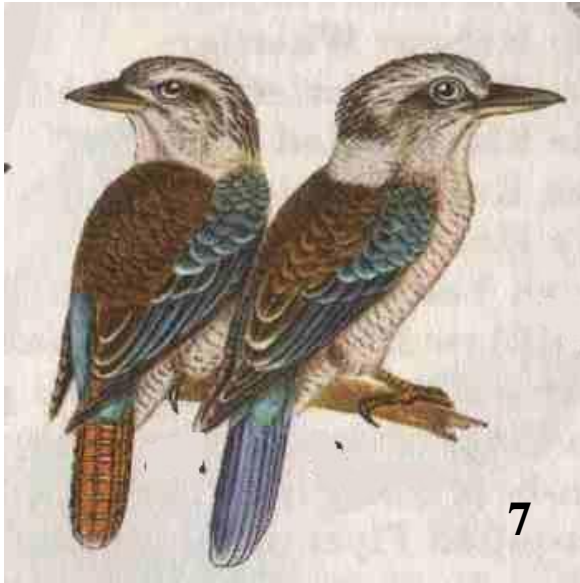
- Cut out the pictures for journal pages.
