My Child is becoming more confident with cursive. She enjoys the fancy letters and is starting to write in cursive by habit. She has also started writing a few stories for fun.

My Child is progressing well in her Math. She understands the concepts easily.

Piano lessons are going smoothly and her teacher is pleased with her progress. Choir continues to be a weekly delight. Her 3 day choir camp was also enjoyed.
